Safe Place

The Mayville Library has become a Safe Place Location. A Safe Place works with the Safe House out of Jamestown. If a youth needs help, all they need to do is enter the facility displaying the yellow sign that reads SAFE PLACE. They let someone in charge know that they need help. The person in charge will contact the Safe Place Agency and someone will come out. A counselor will talk with the youth, provide shelter and transportation if necessary.
